Why This Toolkit Exists:

If you're a course creator, digital author, or content educator, chances are you've asked yourself:

"Is this actually working?"

Comments and completion rates can give hints, but they rarely tell the full story.

This 5-minute feedback form is designed to help you get meaningful, no-fluff input directly from your audience. It's quick, respectful of your learner's time, and powerful enough to highlight what's clear, what's confusing, and what actually resonates.

Whether you're testing a new module, sharing a digital guide, or launching your audiobook, these five questions can quietly open a clear feedback loop — helping you grow your work without second-guessing yourself.

How to Use It:

- Copy the survey into your preferred tool (Google Forms, Typeform, Notion, or email).
- Send it after a learner finishes a key part of your content.
- Keep responses anonymous to encourage honesty.
- Review the responses weekly look for themes or repeat comments.

The 5-Minute Feedback Questions

- 1. What was the most useful or surprising thing you learned?
- 2. What part (if any) felt unclear, too fast, or confusing?
- 3. How did this content make you feel?
- 4. What would you change or add to make this even better?
- 5. Would you recommend this to a friend? Why or why not?
